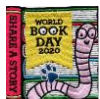


Dear Families and Friends,

**Medication:** If you wish for your child to have an over the counter medication, such as Calpol / eye drops, please ensure that this is brought into school in the original packaging, with the instructions included. Over the counter medication, will only be administered to a child where written permission for that particular medicine has been obtained from the child's parent/carer. Forms to complete will be available from the school office and will need to be dated, include the parents/carers name and address, your child's full name, the dosage and frequency of dosage to be administered, the period for which the medicine should be used, the period of use including the end date and be signed. Written permission will also require you to indicate the purpose for which the medicine is being used (i.e. 'For conjunctivitis'). Unfortunately, we will not be able to accept any request for open-ended use (ie. to administer hay-fever medication for an unspecified period of time).



**Dance Festival:** Congratulations to the Year 2 pupils who came **first** in a Dance Festival. The girls were fantastic and thoroughly deserved their success. Thank you to our amazing parents who came to support us.
