We are pleased to share that our procedures and guidelines for administering medicine have now been revised across the Spencer Academies Trust schools to include non-prescription/over the counter medication. If you wish for your child to have an over the counter medication, such as Calpol / eye drops, please ensure that this is brought into school in the original packaging, with the instructions included.

Over the counter medication, will only be administered to a child where written permission for that particular medicine has been obtained from the child's parent/carer. Forms to complete will be available from the school office and will need to be dated, include the parents/carers name and address, your child's full name, the dosage and frequency of dosage to be administered, the period for which the medicine should be used, the period of use including the end date and be signed. Written permission will also require you to indicate the purpose for which the medicine is being used (i.e. 'For conjunctivitis'). Unfortunately, we will not be able to accept any request for open-ended use (ie. to administer hay-fever medication for an unspecified period of time).
